The West Horsley Dairy Story



1992 was a remarkable year: John Major signed the Maastricht Treaty; Bill Clinton won his first race for the White House & Betty Boothroyd became the first woman to be elected as Speaker in the House of Commons. But the year was even more remarkable for two young entrepreneurs in the village of West Horsley who shared a dream of starting a business.

Twenty years later; that small fledgling business which initially boasted a few dozen retail customers; a single dilapidated vehicle & mountains of ambition has become one of the most respected dairy distributors in the region employing over 100 local people. Many of those initial employees are still with the Company to this day, and the next generation of family are now actively involved in the business.

As the number of retail customers declined throughout the 1990's; the Company's focus turned to the Foodservice market which now constitutes the core customer base. What originally started as a retail dairy supplier has since diversified both geographically & by product into one of the dominant foodservice distributors in the Home Counties.

After rapidly outgrowing the family home, the business relocated to new premises in Brooklands; via Cobham and latterly into their purpose built facility in Woking, Surrey. In 2009 there was further expansion when a second depot in Hampshire was opened, extending the distribution area down to the South coast.

Our Company mission statement, **Delivering Excellence** has been our business ideal for the past twenty years and we will never lose sight of this fundamental reason behind our success.

As we now look forward to our next twenty years; our focus will continue to be on sourcing products locally; reducing our food-miles and embracing new technologies to reduce our impact on the environment. We will continue to develop strong trading partnerships with customers & suppliers alike to ensure we remain the region's premier, independent food service distributor.



Cheese

With the continuing resurgence of British cheese making in recent years, we have developed relationships with a number of small cheese makers in the South of England to offer a splendid selection of high quality, locally produced cheeses. So if you want a blue cheese from the New Forest, an Emmental style cheese from Sussex or a goat's cheese from Wiltshire, we can satisfy your needs. We are continually developing our cheese range and are happy to source new specialist cheeses our customers may request.

Below we have outlined some simple tips for creating an excellent cheeseboard

When preparing a cheese board, plan on serving from three to five cheeses (any more than that will overwhelm the palate). You want to tempt the taste buds with cheeses of distinctly different styles, tastes, and textures.

For a more creative twist, build your cheese board around a theme. You might offer cheeses from different milks (cow, sheep, and goat) or cheeses from a particular region or country.

Differently shaped and coloured cheeses will help to make the cheeseboard visually interesting.

For a simple, but interesting cheese board, start with these three selections: one soft cheese (e.g. White Velvet, Tunworth), one firm cheese (traditional Farmhouse Cheddar, Lyburn Gold) and one blue vein cheese (Oxford Blue, New Forest Blue). To expand your offerings, add goat or sheep milk cheese (Rosary Goats, Duddleswell) and a washed rind cheese (Celtic Promise, Tornegus).

To allow the cheeses to be enjoyed at their best, bring them to room temperature for optimal flavour, so remember to take them out of the refrigerator up to two hours before serving.

Finally serve your cheeses with rustic bread, chutneys from our excellent selection and fresh fruit to complement the range of flavours.


